### KEY POINTS

- Hilo Medical Center has a 5 Stage COVID-19 Management Plan
  - We are currently in Stage 2: Travel-Related Big Island Cases without Community Spread
- Hilo Medical Center plans to ramp up capacity by two-thirds more beds
