<b><u>Cardiac Event Recorder Findings:</u></b>	<b><u>Echocardiogram Findings:</u></b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SVT &gt; 15 seconds</li><li>• VT -3+ beats</li><li>• Ventricular ectopy &gt; 10% recorded beats</li><li>• Sinus brady &lt; 30 beats/min</li><li>• Any AV block other than first degree/Wenckebach at night</li><li>• Pauses &gt; 3 seconds</li><li>• Atrial fibrillation</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• EF &lt; 50%</li><li>• Any valve stenosis/regurgitation moderate or severe</li><li>• Moderate LVH</li><li>• Severe LVH</li></ul>
