

Updated COVID-19 Visitation Requirements

See reverse for definition of **VACCINATED**.

Last edited 1/11/2022

Emergency Dept.

- Effective immediately there will be NO VISITORS allowed into the ED
- Exceptions include pediatric patients
 17 years and below, and highly critical,
 end-of-life situations

Short Stay

- ONLY 1 VACCINATED visitor may accompany patient to check-in only
- Vaccination exceptions include patients 17
 years & below, or patients with special needs

In-Patient

- NO VISITORS for COVID+ patients
- ONLY 1 VACCINATED visitor per day
- Visiting hours and vaccination exceptions include pediatric patients 17 years and below, or breastfeeding moms needing an overnight visitor to assist with the care of the child (other special situation will be handled case by case)
- If the overnight visitors <u>is not vaccinated</u> they must have a COVID test* done upon admission and daily.

Effective Jan. 12, 2021

Due to the rise of COVID numbers in our communities,

Hilo Medical Center

is limiting the number of visitors.

Visiting Hours:

In-Patient: 3:00-7:00pm

Clinics: Duration of appointment

Short Stay: Duration of check-in (and during discharge on an as needed basis)



VISITORS must keep their mask on at all times.

Food and drinks are not allowed.



Visitors unable to follow these safety measures will be asked to leave.

OB (Labor and Postpartum)

- 1 designated birthing partner for the duration hospital stay.
- NO VISITORS for COVID+ moms

Scheduled Induction/C-Section

If the designated birthing partner <u>is</u>
 <u>not vaccinated</u>, they must present a
 negative COVID test* that was
 performed 72 hours prior to
 admission (we suggest getting tested
 when mom goes for testing)

All Other Births

 If the designated overnight birthing partner <u>is not vaccinated</u> they must have a COVID test* performed upon admission

Clinics and Other Services

- 1 caregiver, as needed
- Exceptions may be made for special circumstances

*Visitors are responsible for the cost of their own outpatient COVID test.

Updated COVID-19 Visitation Requirements



For purposes of visitation requirements, a **vaccinated person** is one who has received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized for emergency use in the United States by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). (Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson) Proof of vaccination is required with physical vaccination card or VAMS certificate accompanied by government issued picture identification.

To Our Valued Customers,

We care for our patients and our community. Excellent outcomes are our priority. We understand the importance of having a loved one by your side during these times. We are doing our best to keep you and our community safe.

For those who have an upcoming, scheduled induction or c-section, we urge you to plan ahead. If your loved one, who will stay with you throughout your visit, is not yet vaccinated, have them get a COVID test 72 hours prior to your admission. Please bring the test results with you so it is a smooth process and an excellent experience for all.
